SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The American Nuclear Society is pleased to present our annual Scholarship Program. Recipients will be awarded \$1,000 - \$5,000 based on merit and financial need.

Who is eligible?

Undergraduate and graduate scholarships are open to ANS student members enrolled in a course of study relating to a degree in nuclear science or nuclear engineering.

U.S. and non-U.S. residents may apply if they are enrolled in and attending an accredited institution in the United States.

Incoming freshmen awards are open to graduating high-school seniors who have enrolled, full-time, in college courses and are pursuing a degree in nuclear engineering or have the intent to pursue a degree in nuclear engineering.

DEADLINE: February 1

ANS General Undergraduate/Graduate and all Division-Administered scholarships

DEADLINE: April 1

Incoming Freshman Scholarship and Two-Year College scholarships

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Applicants must be sponsored by a faculty advisor of an ANS Student Section or Alpha Nu Sigma Chapter; secure two references and current school transcripts, and write a 500 word essay.
